## Studio Conversion

Two great institutions in Edinburgh, Scotland, have been reinvented with the help of Aggreko: the landmark Infirmary Street Baths have been recreated as a stunning live, work, and studio space for Dovecot Studios, the new name for the historic Edinburgh Tapestry Company.

When Dovecot Studios wanted to expand production, The Baths – one of several public swimming pools built in Edinburgh by the Victorians in order to combat cholera – were an ideal candidate. But the walls were saturated. Aggreko was brought in to provide dehumidification equipment and prepare the building for renovation.

After completing a full site survey, Sarah Holt, sales engineer UK North, and the service team – Alan Wilks, Andy Connell and Hugh Anderson – provided seven KT1600 dehumidifiers on various levels of the building focusing on particularly saturated areas. In addition, two 320kVA generators were supplied – one as additional site power for construction equipment and the other to act as back-up for the main supply, as the dehumidifiers needed to run continuously.

The new studio opened, on schedule, during the Edinburgh Festival in August.
